

Serrano Creek Ranch COVID -19 Revised Guidelines Updated May 8th, 2020

Dear SCR Boarders:

Over the last few days, state and local governments have eased their stay-at-home orders for golf courses, trails, beaches, tennis courts, etc. In keeping with these modifications, SCR is amending its policies as follows:

1. Trainers are allowed to give lessons to SCR boarders, provided the student has all their own equipment, tack, and horses. Social distancing is required. Masks and gloves are encouraged.
2. Each instructor shall have a maximum of 2 students (not counting SCR boarders) on the stable grounds at any time. Each student will be allowed a maximum of one additional non-riding companion.
3. If the trainer is providing tack, equipment, or horse(s), all of these must be sanitized between each student's use. Trainers must submit a cleaning protocol to the SCR Office and receive approval before commencing lessons.
4. Trainers shall meet students at the patio and escort them directly to their area. Trainers are required to manage all of their students and their student's companions while they are on the stable grounds. Once the lesson is completed, students shall promptly be escorted to their vehicle for departure.
5. Any companion, guardian, or parent shall remain with the trainer and not be allowed to roam about the stable.
6. Any future public health order may supersede some or all of these practices. Should that happen, SCR will modify as appropriate.

SCR boarder time limits at the stable are being relaxed. Again please maintain proper social distancing.
