Winterization has begun! The workers have completed all the stalls in the back area of the stables, and they are currently working hard on the central pipe corrals. If you have not already,



#### Barn Etiquette Series: Riding on the **Trails**

We are truly fortunate to have beautiful trails

that boarders can enjoy, so close to the barn. We ask that you be mindful of our neighbors and others while using the trails. Please always remember to stay on the trail, preventing



horse manure from ending up on the sidewalks. You should alert the office staff if you see an excess amount of horse manure out there so that the workers can clean it up and maintain our neighbors' happiness.

When riding in the park, we also ask that you stay out of the children's play area and stay on the trail wherever possible. When riding on the trail, there is no trotting, loping, cantering, or galloping. Besides it being dangerous, It also raises dust, which prompts complaints from the neighbors. We share the park with the community, so stay alert of other activities going on. Bikes, kids, and dogs can appear unexpectedly! Please be courteous to residents, regardless of their demeanor.

#### AT A GLANCE: SCR Trail Rules

- When on trails, keep two horse lengths between horses
- No riding in the housing tracts
- No trotting, loping, cantering, or galloping in the park and behind the residences
- No ground working of horses in the park
- We recommend a "buddy system" for trail riding at any time
- Stay out of the children's play area

#### **Serrano Creek Park Tree Removal**

Crews are currently working on removing dead trees, stumps, and roots in Serrano Creek Park. The work will last through November. For the duration of the project, large portions of the park will be closed depending on the cutting work location.


